WHY FEES?

*FEES is portable. It can be completed at bedside in a nursing home or assisted living facility or in a physician's office at a medical clinic or hospital.

*Patients do not need to fast or do anything special to prepare for the FEES assessment.

*Morbidly obese patients can receive FEES evaluation.

*FEES provides an in-depth evaluation of swallow function without time limits and radiation exposure, as with Modified Barium Swallow Studies.

*FEES studies may potentially identify lesions within the nasopharynx, thus expediting appropriate referrals to an Ear, Nose, and Throat physician.

*Information regarding swallow efficiency and airway protection is able to be determined and helps the Speech-Language Pathologist formulate a treatment plan specific to the patient being evaluated.

*FEES studies are efficient and are usually completed in ~ 20 minutes or less. A completed report will be ready same day as the FEES study appointment.

Flexible Endoscopic Evaluation of Swallowing for Adults

WHAT IS FEES?

Flexible Endoscopic Evaluation of Swallowing

FEES is one of two gold-standard evaluations of swallowing completed to assess for dysphagia and aspiration.

*An endoscope is inserted into the nose and throat to obtain direct visualization of anatomical structures, including the vocal folds.

*Typically no topical anesthetic is needed, as most patients tolerate the presence of the endoscope without difficulty.

*During the assessment, patients are asked to swallow saliva, liquid, and food while the camera is in place.

*The Speech-Language Pathologist is able to observe aspiration (food or liquid falling into the airway) or swallow inefficiencies (material not fully swallowing into the esophagus, causing residue in the throat).

*During the assessment patients may be asked to say certain sounds allowing the voice box to also be examined.



WHO PERFORMS FEES SERVICES?

Mountain Region Speech & Hearing Center's FEES Program is administered by Speech-Language Pathologists who are licensed in the states of Tennessee and Virginia and have received their Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC) from ASHA. Our SLPs performing FEES studies have been fully trained in the administration of FEES and have received their Endoscopy Certification.
